and includes some 50,532,102 acres that are virtually unknown to humans.

The Volcanic Unit – an arc of undersea mud volcanoes and thermal vents – supports unusual life forms

in some of the harshest conditions imaginable. Here species survive in the midst of hydrothermal vents

that produce highly acidic and boiling water.


The Champagne vent, found at the NW Eifuku volcano, produces almost pure liquid carbon dioxide,
